

ur Philosophy:

Nursing education is best accomplished in a milieu that is flexible in its approach to the teaching-learning needs of Students while maintaining standards of performance based on articulated criteria of competence. Education is an interactive process of study and experience that fosters development in critical thinking communication skills and the cognitive, affective and psychomotor domains. This process best occurs in a climate of mutual respect wherein it is acknowledged that both Students and faculty bring unique Knowledge and experiences to learning. The sharing of this knowledge and experience encourages creative approaches to problem solving and a commitment to continued learning about the Art and Science of Nursing. Learning is a lifelong process enabling Students to assimilate knowledge and develop values, skills, and competencies.

The faculty acknowledges that Students enter the nursing program with a variety of educational and life experiences. Bhagyoday Tirth Nursing College believes that education is a lifelong process that enables participants to build on and modify previously acquired knowledge, skills and attitudes.

The faculty believes that learning and teaching are interactive processes and expects the Student to assume an active role.

The faculty believes in using a variety of instructional strategies to facilitate critica thinking and problem solving. These skills enable the Nurse to make decisions and take actions that are consistent with standards for Nursing practice and laws.

OBJECTIVES:

The B.Sc. and GNM Nursing programme:

- provides a balance of Professional and General education to enable the Student to become a Professional Nurse Practitioner who has self direction and is a responsible citizen.
- provides opportunities to develop broad concepts of principles of nursing care based on sound knowledge and satisfactory level of skill in providing care to all age groups in community or institutional setting.

Admission Requirements to B.Sc. Nursing & GNM programme:

- a.) The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the admission year.
- b.) Nationality: Candidates must be Citizens of India / children or dependents of NRI.
- c.) Minimum educational requirements of B.Sc nursing programme shall be passing of: Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course) or an equivalent from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks. (as per INC norms).
- d) Minimum educational requirements of GNM program shall be the passing of: Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course) or an equivalent from a recognized board or university with any group and minimum of 50% aggregate marks. (as per INC norms).
- e.) Candidate shall be medically fit.

Duration:

Duration of the B.Sc Nursing program shall be four [4] years. Duration of GNM program shall be three half $[3\frac{1}{2}]$ years

How to Apply:

From the date of Admission Notification - Prospectus and the application forms can be obtained from the office of the Principal, Bhagyoday Tirth Nursing College, Sagar - Bina road, Sagar on payment of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundreds only). The Applicant must fill in all the required information in the Original application form in own handwriting. The application submitted should be complete in all respects as below:

Self-attested copies of certificates / documents to be submitted along with Application:

- a) 10th/12th passing certificate as proof of DoB.
- b) Mark sheet of eligible qualifying examination.
- c) Certificate of good conduct issued within last six months from the Institution last attended.
- d) Community certificate, if claim is made for community quota.
- e) Medical fitness certificate from Gazetted Medical practitioner.
- valid Transfer Certificate from the Institute last attended.

Applications not accompanied with above documents or late and incomplete applications will be rejected. Complete applications should be submitted in person to the Manager, Bhagyoday Tirth Nursing College office in person and collect its acknowledgment. Application can also be sent by registered post / speed post with A/D, so as to reach the College office before the last date given in the Admission Notification. College will not be responsible for any delay in delivery by such means.

Documents required at the time of admission (in Original):

- 1. SSLC certificate and plus two certificate / mark sheet.
- 2. Transfer Certificate.
- 3. Conduct Certificate.
- 4. Certificate of excellence in extracurricular activities, if any.
- 5. Migration Certificate.
- 6. Passport size photographs (6 nos.)
- 7. Community certificate, if claim is made for community quota.
- Medical certificate.

Admission:

- A list of selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the College.
 They will also be intimated by letter and telephone (if provided).
- selected Candidates who fail to appear at the appointed date and time are liable to forfeit their seat. Such seats will automatically allocated to the wait listed candidates.
- The Management reserves the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible.
- 4. Candidates selected must join the College immediately by remitting the fees in full for the first year.

Fees:

- 1. The tuition fee and caution deposit, as well as Special fees as per the Government of Madhya Pradesh rules issued thereof shall be paid by the Student at the time of admission.
- Girl Students who opt for hostel facility in Campus shall pay the hostel fee deposit at the time of admission.
- 3. Cost of Uniform, Books, and such expenses can be paid when the classes begin.
- 4. The Student shall pay all the fees for the first year of the course at the time of admission. Thereafter the yearly fee shall be paid at the beginning of each academic year latest by 31st July.
- 5. Fine of Rs. 50/- will be collected against each day of default thereafter.
- 6. If a Student withdraws from the course after start of the new Academic year she/he must pay the full fee of the remaining course. TC and other original certificates will be released only after receipt of the due fees.

Voluntary Withdrawal:

Students who voluntarily withdraw from this College in order to join another College or for any other reason shall be subjected to all the Fees clause 1-6 mentioned above.

THE COURSE

B.Sc NURSING Clinical Experience

Candidates will be posted to Hospitals and Community health centers as specified by Indian Nursing Council norms for the clinical experience.

General Nursing programme:-

Candidates shall pass three board Examinations. Examination will be conducted by the Madhya Pradesh Nurses and Midwives Council every year and a Diploma will be awarded which will qualify the Student for registration. Examination fee will be collected as per Madhya Pradesh Nurses and Midwives Council Stipulation. Fees once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.

Rules & Regulations:

University exams will be conducted ordinarily twice in a year (one regular and one supplementary).

Students shall register for all parts of the examination in the first appearance.

A Student, who remains absent for a total of more than 60 days continuously within a period of 3 months during an academic year, will not be permitted to continue the course in the same batch of Students. She / he may have to obtain special sanction for readmission with the junior batch of Students from the appropriate higher authorities (University / DME / Government of MP)

Students who secure minimum 50% marks, as specified in the scheme of examination shall be declared passed and such Students who pass all parts of the examination on the first attempt shall be ranked as follows:

Second Class: 50% aggregate and above but less than 60% 60% aggregate and above but less than 75%

Distinction: 75% aggregate or above.



General Discipline:

1. Students should be regular and punctual for lectures, demonstrations, seminars, practicals, field work and such other academic exercises. They are required to attend all the allotted working periods in each subjects.

3. Students can avail only 10 days of leave on Medical grounds (detail procedure given below under head "Vacation"). Any absence in excess of this shall result in extension of the course duration.

4. Student should refrain from defacing and damaging Trust / College property.

5. In case of breakage / loss of the Trust / College property management reserves the right to impose and collect an exemplary penalty either individually or collectively to prevent recurrences. Management reserves the right to decide on each case as per

6. The Management, following due inquiry, has the right to expel any Student whose conduct and character are not satisfactory.

- Students attending College / Hospital duty shall wear the prescribed uniforms.
- 2. Students shall wear neat and decent dresses during off duty hours inside the
- 3. Students can wear only minimum jewelry, if they must. (Management will not be responsible for theft or losses if any).

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Selected candidates must attend the classes from the first day of the academic 2.
- Registration to the course is provisional until the University declares Student
- 3. University Fees are subject to change as per notification.
- 5. Fees prescribed for the University Examination will be recovered in due time / year.
- 6. The fee structure mentioned in the Prospectus is liable to be changed as per Government or Court's directions.
- 7. Students whose conduct or attendance or progress is unsatisfactory, will not be allowed to appear for the University examinations.
- 8. In case of absences, an application / explanation must be presented to the Principal for leave or absence stating valid reason.
- 9. Membership of the Student Nurses Association of the College is compulsory. No other Association of Students will be permitted unless they have the prior permission of the Management.
- 10. Students are required to carry Identity Card on their person inside the Campus.
- 11. If a Student leaves the College or is dismissed before completing the course she / he is liable to pay the fees for the entire course of four years.
- 12. Students are strictly prohibited from indulging in activities or associations, be it Union, religious, social, cultural or whatever during the time of their Course or presence inside the Campus.
- 13. Use of Mobile Phone is strictly prohibited.





College Facilities:

Library

A well-furnished library with Reference books (over 5000), Indian and Foreign Journals, plenty of Magazines and Newspapers is available on the 1st floor of the College. The Students are encouraged to make use of the resources of the library while abiding by the rules and regulations. The regular use of the library helps the Students to widen the horizon of their knowledge and also be in touch with the current information and development.

Internet Facility

is available to the staff and Students in the Computer Lab only for doing research work and studies related to Nursing.

Computer Lab

Our well equipped computer lab with internet facility will help each Student gain good e-training.

Hostel:

- 1. The College Hostel provides excellent accommodation for temale Students. It is mandatory that every female Student of Nursing must stay in the hostel provided by the Management. Basic furniture is provided but the Students are expected to bring their own mattress, pillows, bed linen and other items of their personal use.
- The Management does not take responsibility to offer accommodation to male Students.
- 3. The cost of any damage to the Hostel property will have to be made good by the person responsible for the damage. The management reserves the right to impose penalty and other penal deductions caused by any Student for causing damage to the Hostel / College / Trust's property. The decision of the College board will be binding on the Students.
- 4. Administration / Discipline in the hostel is governed by Hostel Rules. A copy of the Hostel Rules and regulations is given to each female Student on admission. These are binding on all Students and any infringement will result in disciplinary action.

Transportation:

The College will provide transport in order to take Students from the College to Hospital or other places of Study / Training / Examinations / Community health service etc. at nominal cost. Students are expected to board the vehicles from the College campus. No pick up or dropping in between is allowed.

Anti - Ragging Oath:

At the time of admission each Student will give a written undertaking as per Supreme Court's direction stating that she / he was not involved in any ragging activity in the past and that she / he shall not indulge in it in future. She / he will report to the Anti Ragging squad / Principal / warden all such incidents of ragging / conspiracy for ragging. On violation of this Oath, the Student will be be expelled from the College and prosecuted.

Anti-Ragging Committee / Squad:

Anti-ragging committee / squad exists in this Institute to maintain vigil and undertake periodic patrolling. The squad shall make surprise raids on hostels and other hot spots to inspect potential ragging

Vacation:

Vacations are planned according to the program of study of each course. All Students are eligible to avail these vacations. If a Student is unable to return on time due to illness, the Principal should be intimated immediately, followed by a written explanation. On return they should submit a medical certificate issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner stating the full particulars of their illness. No other leave will be granted. Any leave other than vacation is counted as 'Absent' with / without permission.

Outside activities:

Students are strictly prohibited from getting involved in out of Course activities: be it Religious, Social, Union, Cultural or any such inside the Campus.
